WHEREAS, in terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, G.A. Educational & Charitable Trust, Plot No.7/20, 21A, E, Street/Road, Ellichathiram Road, Kandambakkammathura Village, Thiruppachavadimedu, Kondangi Post Office, Villupuram Taluk & District - 605301, Tamilnadu has applied for grant of recognition to Sri Vidhyodhaya College of Education, Plot/Khasara No.7/20, 7/21A, 7/21E, Street No.7/20, Thiruppachavadimedu Village, Kondangi Post Office, Villupuram Taluk & District - 605301, Tamilnadu for B.Ed course online on 29.12.2012 for One year duration under section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 and hardcopy received by Southern Regional Committee of NCTE on 03.01.2013.

AND WHEREAS, on scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the affidavit submitted and the report received from VT and videography, and the certificates received from the university, the Committee is satisfied that the applicant fulfils the requirements under the provisions of NCTE Act, Rules and relevant Regulations including the Norms and Standards for the said teacher education programme such as instructional facilities, infrastructural facilities, financial resources, etc., for running the programme.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee, NCTE hereby grants recognition to Sri Vidhyodhaya College of Education, Plot/Khasara No.7/20, 7/21A, 7/21E, Street No.7/20, Thiruppachavadimedu village, Kondangi Post Office, Villupuram Taluk & District, Pin-605301, Tamilnadu for conducting B.Ed programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) from the academic sessions 2015-2016 under Clause 7(16) of NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014 subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs.5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs.7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Loan raising against or mortgaging of FDR's shall not be done.
- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE regulations, as amended from time to time.
- III. The institution shall make admission only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations 2014.
- IV. The institution shall ensure that the required number of academic staff duly approved by affiliating body for conducting the course should always remain in position.
- V. The institution shall comply with the additional facilities required (additional builtup area, additional staff, additional funds etc) for the second unit as prescribed in NCTE (Recognition Norms and Procedure) Regulations 2014 before 31.10.2015.

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2. Further the recognition is subject to the condition that the institution shall move gradually to become a composite institution but not later than 2016-17.
3. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, affiliating University / Body, the State Government etc, as applicable.
4. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Self-Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.
5. The institutions shall maintain its Website with hyperlink to the Council and the Southern Regional Committee, covering inter-alia, the details of the institution, its location, name of the programme applied for with intake, availability of physical infrastructure, such as land, building, office, classrooms, and other facilities or amenities, instructional facilities, such as laboratory and library and the particulars of their proposed teaching faculty and non-teaching staff with photographs, for information of all concerned. The information with regard to the following shall also be made available on the website namely:-
 - a. Sanctioned programmes along with annual intake in the institution;
 - b. Name of faculty and staff in full as mentioned in school certificate along with their qualifications, scale of pay and photograph.
 - c. Name of faculty members who left or joined during the last quarter.
 - d. Names of Students admitted during the current session along with qualification, Percentage of marks in the qualifying examination and in the entrance test, if any, date of admission, etc.;
 - e. Fee charged from students;
 - f. Available Infrastructural facilities;
 - g. Facilities added during the last quarter;
 - h. Number of books in the library, journals subscribed to and additions, if any, in the last quarter;
 - i. The affidavit with enclosure submitted along with application.
 - j. The institution shall be free to post additional relevant information, if it so desires.
 - k. Any false or incomplete information on website shall render the institution liable for withdrawal of recognition.
6. The institution shall adhere to the mandatory disclosure in the prescribed format and display up-to-date information on its official website.
7. The institution shall make available list of students admitted on its official website.
8. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or the provision of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and orders made or issued there under, the institution will render itself vulnerable to adverse action including withdrawal of recognition by the regional committee under the provisions of Section 7(1) of the NCTE Act.

Educational & Charitable Trust, Plot No. 7/20, 21A, E, Street/Road, Ellichathiram Road, Kandambakkammathura Village, Thiruppachavadimedu, Kondangi Post Office, Villupuram Taluk & District, Tamilnadu-605301 vide SRC order no. F.No.SRC/NCTE/SRCAPP2014/B.Ed./2015/61984 dated 25.02.2015 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 100 students (two units) from the academic sessions 2015-2016.

2. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 408th meeting held on 02nd March 2022 has considered the matter and decided to issue a Show Cause Notice to all the colleges of teacher education established even after NCTE Regulations, 2014 at the earliest. Accordingly, as per the decision of SRC Show Cause Notice was issued to the institution on 11.03.2022. The institution has submitted its reply on 05.04.2022.

3. AND WHEREAS, the SRC in its 410th Meeting held on 25th & 26th April, 2022 considered the matter and decided as follows:-

"The original files of the Institution alongwith other related documents, NCTE Act, 1993, Regulations Guidelines issued by NCTE from time to time and documents furnished by the institution were carefully considered by the SRC and the following observations were made:-

The Committee on the perusal of the reply submitted by the institution, decided that the continuation order be issued to the Institution Sri Vidhyodhaya College of Education, Survey No.7/20, 7/21A, 7/21E, 7/3C, Kandampakkam Madhura, Thirupachavadimedu Village, Villupuram Taluk & District, Pin-605301, TamilNadu for B.Ed. programme for 2 basic units of 50 students each."

4. NOW THEREFORE, this order is issued permitting the institution i.e., Sri Vidhyodhaya College of Education, Survey No.7/20, 7/21A, 7/21E, 7/3C, Kandampakkam Madhura, Thirupachavadimedu Village, Villupuram Taluk & District, Pin-605301, TamilNadu run by G.A. Educational & Charitable Trust, Villupuram Taluk & District, Tamilnadu-605301 for Continuation of recognition for B.Ed. programme for two years duration with an annual intake of 2 basic units of 50 students each subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- I. The Endowment fund of Rs. 5 lakhs and Reserve fund of Rs. 7 lakhs kept in joint account with Regional Director of NCTE should be maintained perpetually. Raising loan against the FDRs or mortgaging them shall not be done.

- II. The institution shall comply with the various other norms and standards prescribed in the NCTE Regulations, 2014 as amended from time to time.
 - III. The institution shall make admissions only after it obtains affiliation from the examining body in terms of clause 8(10) of the NCTE (Recognition Norms & Procedure) Regulations, 2014.
